

EMT – Paramedic

An EMT - P is a health care provider who has special skills and knowledge in emergency medical care and responds to cases of sudden illness and injury. An important trait for the EMT - P to exhibit is concern for the health and well-being of others.

An EMT - P is trained to provide emergency and non-emergency care to patients in the pre-hospital setting. An EMT - P must provide this care unsupervised, in a great variety of circumstances, and often under considerable physical and emotional stress. This requires special skills in communications, transportation, record keeping and personal safety.



All training is provided in accordance with the EMT-P National Standard Curriculum and Illinois Department of Public Health rules and regulations.

EMT - P (Paramedic) Course

The EMT – Paramedic course is designed to equip the EMS provider with the ability to apply concepts of anatomy and physiology, clinical decision making and critical thinking for the advanced assessment, management and treatment of pre-hospital patients, including the administration of intravenous fluid therapy, IV Medications, advanced airway control and management, cardiac dysrhythmias recognition and treatment.

Training consists of a didactic course, hospital clinical rotations, and field internship. Hours are based on the DOT National Curriculum, Illinois Department of Public Health, and Peoria Area EMS System requirements.

Pre-Requisites

- Applicants must be a licensed EMT-B or I
- Complete the HOBET Exam (failure of exam doesn't disqualify you from the program). Instructions will be given on how to take this after registration form is received.
- Must have AHA Healthcare Provider CPR prior to first day of class
- Written verification of 1-Year (minimum 1500 Hours) of field experience as an EMT-B or I
- Personal Health Insurance
- Interview with PAEMS Medical Director

Topics of instruction will include the EMT-P Level of:

- Anatomy and physiology
- Patient Assessment
- Advanced Airway Management
- Recognition and care of Traumatic, Medical, Cardiac, and Environmental Emergencies
- Advanced skill development in areas of Treatment of Shock, Cardiovascular Emergencies, Childbirth, Pediatric Emergencies and Special Healthcare Needs

Licensure

Upon successful completion of the course, students may challenge the Illinois Department of Public Health test or the National Registry test. Licensure is granted by the Illinois Department of Public Health for satisfactory scores on either test.
